

Developmental Checklist

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6 months

- says "ma, da, ba"
- rolls back to stomach
- crawls on stomach
- puts weight on hands while on stomach
- plays peek a boo
- shouts for attention

9 months

- creeps on hands & knees
- combines sounds "mama"
- pats mirror image
- transfers objects from hand to hand
- finger feeds self

12 months

- walks around furniture
- use 2-3 meaningful words
- walks with support
- responds to simple commands "No, Stop"
- holds own cup to drink

15 months

- climbs up / down stairs with help on hand/knees
- gets from room to room in the house
- uses spoon, spills some
- points to 1 named body part
- throws ball forward

18 months

- walks fast, seldom falls
- refers to self by name
- remembers where things belong
- beginning to do what is asked of him/her to do
- place rings on a post

24 months

- squats and gets up without using hands
- turns pages of a book one at a time
- names common objects
- identifies 3 or more pictures
- uses simple sentences

30 months

- jumps forward using both feet
- names use of 1 or more common objects
- holds crayon in fingers, not fists
- builds tower of 7 or 8 blocks

36 months

- stands on 1 foot momentarily
- obeys 2 preposition directions (i.e. put the ball on the chair)
- builds a tower of 8 or 9 blocks
- plays with others (groups)
- uses more complete sentences (4-5 words)



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
